**Start up of the "Instituts für

The main goal of the Institute is to form a system of accompanying, taking care, supporting and nursing so that it is granted that people with impairments are helped in every situation and at every moment in their individual needs, their abilities, as well as integrated help aimed at their life style. The help should be measured in the way and extent and be oriented in the principle of the participants and self determination and be agreed upon in a dialogue with the clients. The organization of the aid should be oriented on the person, occur in coordination through the local authority district / area municipality and be covered, next to the cultural, social and economic relations of the region and the social space. Personal centering tries to perform competent professional escorting as far as possible in the immediate social environment and the set up for this the organizational and structural conditions. Thereby, the life aims and resources of the person should stand in the center, the resources in the social space introduced and their care gives people / families as their neighbors and colleagues be supported with a lasting effect. **AmiQuSINSS: Older Migrants in the Neighbourhood**

On April 1, 2009 the research project "Older migrants in the Neighbourhood – Support and Initiation of networks for the self organization and self-help" starts. The project is a group project of the Universities of Applied Sciences Wiesbaden and Fulda and is being promoted for three years by the Federal Research Ministry within the scope of the program SILQUA FH. In the center of this project stands not only the barriers, but above all the conditions and resources for an adequate lifestyle of older people with migration background in differently structured parts of town of German cities. In addition heterogeneous groups of older migrants are looked at differentiated, as well as part of town structures, that open or complicate access. In the Fulda main research focus under the direction of Prof. Dr. Monika Alisch the district chapter AWO Fulda Town and County registered society as well as the Nassauische Heimstätte Wohnstadt could be won as a cooperation partner. The project group under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Michael May of the Wiesbaden FH cooperates in the project, moreover, closely with the Wiesbaden Inhabitant and Integration Office, the Office for Statistics and Urban Research as well as several community organizations. In the Munich comparative part of town the Diakonie Hasenberg e.v. is the local practice partner with which common projects with the older migrants should originate.

**Integrated Access Planning**

Prof. Dr. Petra Gromann is responsible since January 2009 for the scientific accompanying and administration of the training within the framework of the implementation of the Integrated Access Plan Hessen including the person-centered financing change of all services and arrangements of all target groups of the handicapped help and local psychiatry in the city and district Fulda as well as the Werra Meissner area by order of the Landeswohlfahrtsverbandes Hessen.

Petra Gromann has been assigned within the framework of the Projects of the Workers' Welfare Association "Participation" and "Individual budget" for the Aktion Mensch for the project duration of two years as an expert and the scientific accompanying.
